

WEBINAR: Montana Accessibility Inventory:

Utilizing Technology & Student Engagement to Remove Barriers and Implement its Americans with Disabilities (ADA) Transition Plan

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) was awarded an America's Transportation Award from the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) for its Montana accessibility inventory and investment program. The program utilized aerial photography, a field inventory of intersections across the state, and GIS mapping software to collect information on accessibility issues. A process for prioritizing funding to upgrade intersections is being used to identify and fund accessibility and safety improvement projects in the state. The program's innovative use of tablets and student interns to complete the field inventory covering 56,000 vehicle miles will be highlighted.
